Reopening Plan for April 6th

We are so excited to have students on campus for a longer school day starting Tuesday, April 6th. Our school day will start at 7:55 am and go until 11:55 am. Students will be allowed to be dropped off between 7:45 and 7:55 each day. To manage the amount of students who will be entering campus, we ask that you drop your student off in the following areas:

4th grade- Drop off/pick up in the front by the school office

5th grade - Drop off/pick up on the side gate near the basketball courts (Nevada Street)

6th grade - Drop off/pick up in the back area by the MPR.

Each of these areas will be staffed with employees who will be taking temperatures and have masks available for the students if needed. Since students will be here for a longer period, we will be giving them a small break time during the day. If they would like to bring a snack or equipment to play with for this break they may. During this time, they will be staying with their classroom cohort and will be required to wear masks unless they are eating. Meals will be done the same way as they are now, where students are given their meals for the day when they leave. Yearbooks


