Student Discipline Procedures

- Students who abuse classroom or school rules will be issued a detention and/or a referral.
- Time assigned in detention will be based on the severity of the offense.
- Days of suspension will be based on the severity of the offense.
 - 3 Tardies = One (1) detention
 - 5 Detentions = One (1) referral
 - No Show to Detention or Principal's Intervention/Defiance = One (1) referral
 - 5 Referrals = One (1) day Sat. school or in/out-school suspension.
 - First Suspension = Student will be put on a Behavior Contract.
 - Second Suspension = Student & Parent will meet with the Preliminary Administrative Review Panel
 - Continual Disciplinary Actions = Student & Parent will meet with the Administrative Review Panel for possible expulsion

Student Rewards and Incentives

To qualify for the quarterly reward activities:

- Students must have a qualifying GPA (2.0).
- Students may have no more than 1 tardy (1st period or between classes).
- Students may have no more than 1 referral.
- Students may not have any unexcused absences.
- Students may not have any current "F" in a class.
- Students that have been suspended or have a suspended expulsion are not eligible.

End of the Year Special Activities Requirements

To qualify for the 7th grade pool party and the 8th grade Wild Water trip:

- Students may not have received more than 8 referrals per school year.
- Students may not have more than 2 suspensions per school year.
- Students may not have more than 12 tardies per school year.
- Students that have a suspended expulsion during the year are not eligible.
