1. Call to Order

- a. Roll call of all present-Nancy Tikkanen-District EL Coordinator, Grace Macal-Rafer, Elena Sanchez-Lincoln, Hortencia Barraza-Washington

2. Program Business

- a. Title III plan update

Mrs. Tikkanen updated that she is still waiting for state guidance on the upcoming Title III addendum. The form will be completed and will include the proposed Title III budget. We will continue to budget for EL Summer School, additional materials to increase student's proficiency and focus on students that are at risk of becoming Long Term English Learners (LTEL). There will be additional continuing professional development, coaching and supporting opportunities. Early literacy programs such as Latino Family Literacy and ESL programs will also be offered during the school year to engage parents. Last year's Title III allocation was \$36,788, but LCAP funds are also used to provide services for English Learners. The Title III addendum template should be released at the end of May.

- b. Consolidated Application Review 2018-19

Mrs. Tikkanen reviewed the Consolidate Application proposal. 25% of the EL Coordinators salary is paid through Title III funds to provide professional development, coaching and support for both integrated and designated ELD. Supplemental materials for newcomers, such as the Inside program and Imagine Learning will continue to be purchased to support newcomers.

- c. LCAP Review

Mrs. Tikkanen reported that the LCAP is still under construction for the 2018-19 school year. Goal 1 focuses on preparing all students for mastery of the CCSS. Our district focuses on SLOP to support all students and has been effective with reaching our English Learners We will continue to train our new teachers and support them throughout the year. Summer planning has been very helpful to align ELA standards to our new ELD standards to help address the needs of our

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English Learners. Goal 6 focuses on student achievement. Paraprofessionals were maintained to support student learning and also provide additional resources to our newcomers. Ongoing professional development will continue for designated ELD. Summer school will also continue for the summer of 2018. Goal 7 focuses on professional learning for all staff. The district will continue to provide professional development and academic coaching/support to increase the achievement of our EL's. Additional professional development for integrated ELD will be added to the 2018-2019 school year to improve academic discussion.
