

Rafer Johnson Cell Phone Policy

As per EC 48901.5, students are allowed to carry cell phones with the following condition: phones are required to be turned off during school hours (From first bell in the morning until last bell at the end of the day) and **in their backpack**.

Students caught with their cell phones on, which includes silent and/or vibrate status, or not off and in their backpack are subject to the following:

1st Offense: Warning – If phone is used in class or on campus, or out of the backpack, cell phone is taken to office and logged on a data sheet. Student will be required to pick up his/her phone at the end of the school day. Data sheet will note the following: Student name, classroom or location where phone was used, date, and person who removed the phone from the student's possession.

2nd Offense: Parents are called and informed of the student's use of cell phone on campus as well as the school policy. Student will receive a detention. Parents are required to pick up cell phone in the office.

3rd Offense: Parents are called and informed of the 3rd offense. Student will receive a referral. Parents are required to pick up cell phone in the office.

4th Offense: Parents are required to meet with school personnel and a behavior contract is issued and signed by all parties. Student will not be allowed to have a cell phone at school.

If personal property is lost, damaged, or stolen while on district property or district-sponsored trips, the district assumes no responsibility or liability.
