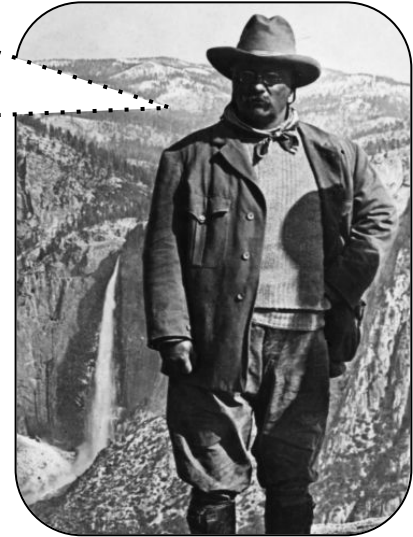

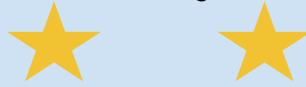
**Ice Cream on sale every Friday after lunch for a \$1.00**
